1. Program Operators Onboarding Update-Luis Servin

Luis reported that the Youth Program went through an EDD monitoring where they interview staff, interviewed youth and reviewed case files. He shared that monthly Managers meeting are scheduled and that WDB staff are meeting with leadership team as needed.

A programs report card has been created that will be have all contracted goals and will be used to measure operators performance.

Youth polices, dependency policy, follow-up services policy are being finalized by Luis and once completed will be provide to operators.

Sub recipient monitoring will be happening by contractor Kathy Marcove.

WDB is looking into Launch Pad that is a data entry system to help with businesses services.

STEPS is a new project that is serving DOR youth and Goodwill is operating that program with WDB oversight and referrals from DOR.

2. Program operator update, Osvaldo Sotelo

Osvaldo shared that the Lompoc Youth Center is under construction and is looking very promising. It was discussed that it we could have next Youth Committee meeting before the Grand opening. Mary from EDD can put a PSA for Goodwill Lompoc Youth Center grand opening.

Chuck met with Ingrid to have WIOA partner with their Lompoc center.

3. Lompoc Youth Center update- Tim Harrington

Focus group with other non profits in area that felt they could be valuable to youth and set up shop, One Stop for Youth; Location: Hancock college met with Tim; Trevor McDonald to see how they can be a partner; General Manager of Ratheon in Lompoc and can come in and talk about robotics, ojt etc; 10 people that want to be part of advisory board; 10-12 people in community

have offered their services for the youth center and Tim and chuck will vet them; met with city manager of Lompoc and see how they can help with job shadowing; WDB that will address with foundation; interview with KVSY; building, opportunity zone, has approached people willing to buy property and be willing to use as youth center; 2 more months of funding for work on this, meeting with FSA to develop operation budget

4. Summer Jobs for Youth 2020- Ray McDonald

Wants Youth Committee to support and brainstorm on how we can get a privately funded program. Some ideas that were shared on this topic included the following:

Verdugo (Glendale)-Judy- Youth Focused hiring event; the need for Employer buy-in; beneficial to explore and see what the schools are doing, etc for Summer Jobs 2020

5. CWA Youth Conference- Raymond McDonald

Ray shared with Youth Committee that CWA Youth Conference will be held in January 13th-16th 2020 in San Jose and invited all Youth Committee Members to attend and WDB would cover conference registration cost and hotel. Dianne, Tim, and Jesse confirmed they would like to attend.
